



NAP Details

Fluvanna County Habitat for Humanity has been approved as a Neighborhood Assistance Program (NAP) qualified organization for the July 1, 2015-June 30, 2016 fiscal year. Qualified NAP organizations are given an allowance of Virginia State Tax credits to give to donors on a yearly basis. For individuals, a minimum donation of \$500 is required, for trusts and businesses the minimum donation is \$616.00. 65% of that donation is then eligible for Virginia State Tax Credits, meaning a \$500 donation could receive \$325 in tax credits, while a \$616 minimum donation from a business could receive \$400 back in state tax credits.

For the July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016 fiscal year Fluvanna Habitat has been allotted \$13,000 in credits. Credits are issued on a first come, first served basis. Once they have been given out, there is no guarantee that we will receive any more. **Therefore, donate early!!**

Fluvanna Habitat is one of only two organizations that are NAP approved in Fluvanna County. The Neighborhood Assistance Program began in 1981, and is run through the Department of Social Services. Only non-profit organizations that have showed sustained success in helping lower income families may apply to be in the NAP Program.

To utilize the program, a donor must fill out a very simple half page form to be sent in with their check. Fluvanna Habitat fills out the rest of the form, sends it, along with a copy of the check, to the Virginia Department of Social Services, and within 6-8 weeks the donor receives a certificate for their tax credits directly from the state. It is a very easy program to use, and the benefits to Fluvanna Habitat are enormous.
